Thank & Help A Veteran Today!

When you see a veteran, "Thank that Veteran Today!"

After an Eternal Honor service held on board Miramar National Cemetery that I led for an American hero, a young man who attended the service came to me and said, "Can I shake your hand Sir? I want to Thank You for your service!" I responded, "Oh, Yes! Thank you so much!" His parents taught him very well about our veterans.

Two Acts of Love you and I can do for our veterans:

First, when you see a veteran, Thank That Veteran! Second, offer a helping hand to the struggling veterans. We must never forget to help and thank all our veterans today and every day!

A "Military veteran refers to a person who has served or is serving in the armed forces." The VA estimates that there are 5.9 million American veterans who served during the Vietnam era and 7.8 million who served in the Gulf War era, which spans from August 1990 through the present. There are also around 240,000 World War II veterans and about 933,000 who served during the Korean conflict, the VA estimates."

Recent statistics projected the number of U.S. veterans in 2024 is "17.5 million, which is a decrease from 21.6 million in 2014. The population will have a slightly higher proportion of older veterans. Additionally, there are an estimated 5.44 million living American veterans of the Vietnam War."

When you have an opportunity to see a veteran, please greet and thank that veteran today.

The Apostle Paul said, "in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you." 1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NKJV). "Everything" means all.

When you see a veteran, "Thank that Veteran Today!"

According to the San Diego Chamber of Commerce "Military Employment in San Diego" Report: More than 240,500 veterans reside in San Diego and another 370,000 live in Los Angeles County. Military veterans make up more than 13% of the population of San Diego County.

When you see a veteran, "Thank that Veteran Today!"

San Diego County has the largest concentration of military personnel within California. There are approximately 110,700 Active-Duty personnel and 118,300 family members, which represents 7.6 percent of San Diego County's total population. An estimated 60.7 percent (71,759) of military families in San Diego County is children.

WWII Veterans

May 8, 2020, marks the 75th anniversary of V-E Day, when World War II came to an end in Europe. In the United States, V-E Day commemorations honor the 16 million Americans who served during the war. About 300,000 American WWII veterans were still alive during the 75th anniversary of V-E Day. 245 WWII veterans are expected to be lost each day. These projections were calculated before the COVID-19 pandemic and do not take any deaths related to that disease into account. The last living American veteran from WWII is projected to die in 2044. I have had so many opportunities to say Thank you for the sacrificial service of WWII Veterans.

For instance, I volunteered four times during the Honor Flight San Diego since May 2019 to September 2024. I thanked about 360 WWII, Korean, and Vietnam veterans and their family members and volunteers who visited the war memorials and other sights in the Nation's capital.

During the flight back to San Diego, I met and spoke for about an hour with Frank Manchel, a 95-year-old WWII soldier. About 30 minutes later following our conversation and about an hour to our destination, Frank collapsed on the passageway. Out medical team members helped him. Sadly, Comrade Frank never regained consciousness. He died aboard about an hour before the chartered American Airlines jet was due to land Sunday 5 May 2019 in San Diego.

Secondly, twelve years ago, I met SEN Claiborne Pell and his wife Naula in 2008 in Newport, RI. I thanked the Senator for his public service, military service in the USCG, and for the Pell Grant. He died not long after I met him on Jan 2, 2009.

Korean Veteran

Thirdly, CAPT Thomas Hudner, MOH, Korean Veteran...When I was stationed on board Naval Station Newport, I had opportunities to thank him for his service during the Korean and Vietnam War. USS Thomas Hudner DDG-116 is named in his honor. CAPT Hudner was able to witness the Christening of a US ship named after him honoring his sacrificial services. He died on 13 Nov 2017 in MA. Thirteen months later the destroyer was commissioned on 4 Dec 2018 in Boston, MA.

Vietnam Veteran

"A SALUTE TO VIETNAM VETERANS" – The Theme of the annual largest military AIR SHOW" HELD ON 22-24 SEP 2017 ON BOARD MCAS MIRAMAR.

We had ample opportunities to say "Thank you so much" to about 600 Vietnam Veterans (VV) and their families. We held two "Thank You" services each day for three days. We were honored to have so many guests including American heroes, Clebe and Deanna McClary were our special guest speakers.

I was blessed to serve as Chaplain and Guardian during the Honor Flight San Diego (HFSD) on September 27-29, 2024, from San Diego to Washington, DC. HFSD and the volunteer guardians were able to say "Thank you for your service" to 90 WW-II-, Korean and Vietnam Veterans for their sacrificial and faithful service.

After a Celebration of the Life of Summer (niece of Pearl Harbor survivor Ray Chavez), I had a privilege of Honoring four Vietnam Veterans for their service to our Country. In less than a year, one of the four VV died. Before it's too late, When you see a veteran, "Thank that Veteran Today!"

During a very meaningful seven-state-journey with Missionaries Doyle and Linda Moore on October 19-26, 2021, I had a chance of thanking Brother Doyle for his military service in the U.S. Army. He and his wife Linda were so happy that they were able to stay two nights / three days inside the Naval Air Base for the first time.

When you see or take a trip with a veteran, "Thank that Veteran Today!"

A Vietnam Veteran named Mike Michael Sipe accompanied me during the 75th Anniversary of Leyte Landing led GEN Douglas MacArthur, US Army, on 20 October 2019. We led the OHOA (Operation Help One Another) and joined with the Medical Mission Team led by the Godly nun, Sister (Dr) Eva Maamo. We provided medical, monetary, and food to many WWII veterans and other era-veterans. We were able to say "Thank you for your sacrificial service" to the Filipino, Australian, New Zealand, and American WWII veterans. When you see a veteran who needed assistance, help and "Thank that Veteran Today!"

At the time of writing, four Gulf War/Iraqi War veterans and a spouse of veteran & registered nurse are scheduled to say "Thank you so much for your service" to more than a dozen living WW-II veterans and their families during the 80th Anniversary of the Leyte Landings on October 20, 2024, Palo, Leyte, Philippines. We are expecting several thousand participating the multiple events on October 18-20, 2024, in Tolosa, Dulag, Tacloban, and Palo, Leyte, Philippines.

Four years ago, on November 10, 2020, our VFW Post 7907 hosted honoring and thanking the veterans in attendance and celebrating the U.S. Marine Corps 245th Birthday. Joe Crutcher, U.S. Navy veteran, was one of more than a hundred in attendance. We thanked him for his service. In less than a year, Joe was promoted to heaven on 7 Nov 2021.




