Memorial Day Weekend Tribute to WWII Heroes Buried in Asia

In retrospect, more than 500 veterans, families, friends, and activeduty service members (United States and the Republic of the Philippines) participated during the annual Memorial Day Service on Sunday May 27, 2018, remembering, and honoring 17,206 buried on the hallowed grounds of Manila American Cemetery, the largest World War II cemetery outside of the United States located in Manila, Philippines.

In addition, all in attendance paid tribute to 36,286 Missing in Actions (MIAs) whose names are inscribed on rectangular Trani limestone piers within the hemicycles made of marbles imported from Italy.

I (Chaplain Don Biadog, former Command Chaplain, MCAS Miramar) led the Memorial Prayer. Doctor Jim Linzey (US Army MAJ Ret) led the Benediction.

Last year, May 28, 2023, I was invited by the U.S. Ambassador to Philippines to attend the Memorial Day Ceremony. It was an honor

to visit the hallowed grounds where the WW-II War dead heroes are buried once again.

God willing, I plan of returning and visit the largest American cemetery outside of the United States, the Manila American Cemetery on May 26, 2024, Taguig, Metro Manila, Philippines. This time my main mission is to locate the names of the Missing in Action of James J. Redden, Delfin Dolonguines, and Delfin E. Hilario located on the on rectangular Trani limestone within the hemicycles. I met their family members on my journey in the USA.

On this Memorial Day weekend, find a way to visit the resting place(s) of our Nation's heroes.

Say their names inscribed on gravestones or memorial markers and say a prayer for their families.


